The Volunteer (and Guardian) understands that the activities may include constructing and rehabilitating residential buildings, working in the Habitat Storage Facility, being transported to and from work camp locations, and consuming food donated for the home building program. The Volunteer (and Guardian) does hereby freely, voluntarily, and without duress execute this Release under the following terms: 1. Waiver and Release. Volunteer (and Guardian) does hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless Habitat and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from Volunteer's participation in Habitat's home building program. Volunteer (and Guardian) understands that this Release discharges Habitat form any liability or claim that the Volunteer may have against Habitat with respect to any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from Volunteer's participation in Habitat's home building program. Volunteer (and Guardian) also understands that Habitat does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health, or disability insurance. 2. Medical Treatment. Volunteer (and Guardian) does hereby release and forever discharge Habitat from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's "Activities" with Habitat or (in case of a minor child) with the decision by any representative or agent of Habitat to exercise the power to consent to medical or dental treatment as such power may be granted and authorized in the Parental Authorization for Treatment of a Minor Child.. 3. Insurance. The Volunteer (and Guardian) understands that Habitat does not carry or maintain health medical, or disability insurance coverage for any Volunteer. Each Volunteer is expected and encouraged to obtain his or her own medical or health and auto insurance coverage. 5. Media Release. Volunteer (and Guardian) does hereby grant and convey unto Habitat all right, title, and interest in any and all photographic images and video or audio recordings made by Habitat during Volunteers' Activities and with Habitat, including, but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds, or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings. 6.
